COMPLETE MISSIONS GIVEN BY MOTHER EARTH.

Answer questions in four categories, together.
Right answers lead you closer to saving the planet.
For each wrong answer, you receive damage cards that will block your way.

- Co-operational gameplay
- Rotating board and sliding cards
- Multiple choice questions



ON YOUR TURN: Roll the dice and rotate the inner circle. Slide available cards from the outer circle (not all fit). Move the pawn (only on the inner circle) and answer that question, together. Fill the cards on the outer circle from the category decks.

ENOUGH RIGHT ANSWERS: Move the card to the center of the board. Aim to collect the right amount of category cards (on Mother earth's mission card).

<u>MOT ENOUGH</u> RIGHT ANSWERS: Discard the card and place a Damage card on the outer circle. It will block 1 of the places ...but which one? It adds strategic play. Note: Damage card can also come from the A-B-C die.

GAME ENDS:

- If too many Damage Cards are played.
- All players complete their Missions.
